Leighton Asia secures A\$260 million drainage project in Hong Kong

12 November 2008

Leighton Asia has been awarded a contract for the design and construction of the Lai Chi Kok Transfer Scheme by the Hong Kong Drainage Services Department.

The project, worth A\$260 million, provides for the design and construction of two storm water drainage tunnels with a total length of 3.7 kilometres and having an internal diameter of 4.9 metres. The work also includes six intake shafts, a stilling basin, an outfall structure and approximately 270 metres of three metre internal diameter connection adits.

The Lai Chi Kok drainage tunnel will capture rainwater from the upper catchment in West Kowloon and discharge it into Victoria Harbour to alleviate flooding of the low lying, highly developed areas of Kowloon.

Works starts in November 2008 for completion in 2012.

Hamish Tyrwhitt, managing director of Leighton Asia said, "The award of this contract recognises Leighton Asia's key position as a major infrastructure contractor in Hong Kong. The work is technically challenging as the major tunnel works are at a depth of up to 80 metres in difficult rock condition. Leighton Asia's local and international experience in handling difficult tunneling projects was a significant factor in securing this work."

Leighton Asia has been awarded a contract for the construction of a resort and residential complex on Koh Samui in Thailand. Scheduled to open in 2010, Conrad Koh Samui Resort and Spa will be the newest luxury villa property on the popular Thai island.

The property is being developed by Hong Kong company Hillcrest Resorts (Samui) Company Limited which specialises in property development and investment across Asia Pacific.
