Leighton Contractors awarded \$116 million Dynon Port Rail Link Project

Leighton Contractors has been awarded a \$116 million design and construction contract for the Dynon Port Rail Link project in Melbourne by the Victorian Department of Infrastructure.

The Dynon Port Rail Link is a joint project of the Victorian and Australian Governments and will involve the construction of a direct, uninterrupted rail link into the Port of Melbourne.

The works to be constructed will include an elevated section of Footscray Road over the rail track connection into the port precinct, and an elevated section of Appleton Dock Road and Enterprize Road, integrated with the existing Footscray Road overpass.

Two new dual gauge main lines will be constructed between the new port junction and the existing main line north of Footscray Road, as well as associated signalling works and the reinstatement of the ground level service road along Footscray Road.

Peter McMorrow, Managing Director of Leighton Contractors, said today the successful award of this project enables the company to showcase its expertise in delivering projects with multiple and complex infrastructure requirements.
